Subject: Online reporting system for information on Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) payments in identified schemes of MoHFW regarding.

Dean colleague,

Please refer to Secretary's D.O. letter No. Z. 14018/33/2012-JSY dated 14.12.2016 on the above subject.

2. This Ministry vide its said letter informed the States/UTs that to avoid delays in submission of reports and ensure the accuracy, an online reporting system **http://rbsk.gov.in/tempdbt** has been developed, wherein monthly DBT data of the identified schemes i.e. JSY, Family Planning, ASHA incentives and payment to contractual staff under NHM may be reported.

3. User ID and password to access the web application along with the user manual were sent to the States/UTs with the request to ensure that the DBT data in respect of the identified schemes gets reported on **http://rbsk.gov.in/tempdbt** by the last day of month i.e. $30^{\text{th}}/31^{\text{st}}$ of every month.

4. Since then, States/UTs have started utilising the online web application for reporting the DBT data. However; some States/UTs are yet to submit the DBT progress reports online, due to which the complete picture of DBT payments could not be ascertained and reported to the Cabinet Secretariat.

5. Given that DBT is a high priority area and is being reviewed at the highest level in the Government, I request you to expedite submission of DBT progress reports online in the identified schemes of MoHFW.
