Bloody vomits




Altered mental status

When to suspect?

- Sinusitis-nasal blockade or congestion
- Nasal discharge (blackish/bloody)
- Local pain on the cheekbone
- One-sided facial pain, numbness or swelling

- Toothache
- Blurred or double vision with pain



Chest pain, worsening of respiratory symptoms



Dos

- Control hyperglycemia
- 02 Monitor blood glucose level post-COVID-19 discharge
- 03 Use steroid judiciously
- 04 Use clean water for humidifiers during oxygen therapy
- 05 Use antibiotics/antifungals judiciously
- 06) Wear a mask if you are going outside



Don'ts

- Miss warning signs and symptoms
- Consider all cases with a blocked nose is due to fungus
- Hesitate to seek tests like KOH staining, microscopy, culture, MALDI-TOF to detect fungal etiology
- Hesitate to initiate treatment
