

Sr. Consultant / Consultant – Urban Health Planning

Terms Of Reference

1. Systematic collection, documentation & Presentation of information regarding urban health system, health needs and inputs to the decision makers
2. Analysis of data from HMIS & its use for decision makers.
3. Building capacities at district and state level for making urban health plans and for review & improving the plans, using both epidemiological and HMIS inputs. Budgeting and financial planning as required by the poor performing states.
4. Provide technical assistance for implementation of the NUHM and its goals at center, and in states, as may be agreed upon from time to time
5. Evolving mechanism for engaging with Not For Profit and Private Sector.
6. Mobilizing technical assistance inputs for MOH&FW for preparation of Terms of Reference, inviting proposals/ application etc.
7. Undertake other assignments, which may be assigned from time to time by the Reporting Officer.

Eligibility:

- Post graduation or higher qualification in Public health, Community health, Preventive & Social Medicine.
- Published work in the area of health systems or public health. (Desirable)
- At least 5 years for Sr. Consultant and 2 years for Consultant - post qualification work experience in Health Systems Research or in Planning and implementation of service delivery.
- Relevant work experience demonstrating required skills and domain knowledge in Public Health Sector and Private Health Sector.
- Computer proficiency with high level of familiarity with commonly used packages like MS Word, Excel, Power Point & Web surfing to search relevant data & documents.
- Familiarity with any one computerized accounting package is highly desirable.
- Excellent communication and presentation skills, analytical and interpersonal abilities, excellent oral and written communication skills in English.
- Demonstrated ability to work in a multi-disciplinary team environment.
- Demonstrated experience in operationalizing health programme at field level / working in strengthening of district level health systems.
- Willingness to travel to states & districts to provide technical assistance & ability to work on different assignments simultaneously to meet the timelines for assignments.
- Age up to 45 years.
