- Provide technical advice and expertise, based on a robust understanding of state and district realities, review of secondary literature including global evidence in the assessment of the ASHA and community Processes and enable redesign/realignment as required in the present context.

- Undertake analysis of survey and programmatic data to identify trends in key primary health care outcomes and enable appropriate policy and programmatic modifications
- Build partnerships with research., academia and civil society agencies to undertake capacity building, research and advocacy for CP and CPHC.
- Work closely with other divisions within NHSRC, RRC-NE and other stakeholders as required
- Undertake other tasks which may be assigned from time to time by the Executive Director.
