Terms of Reference Consultant – Certification Cell (Quality Improvement Division)

National Health Systems Resource Centre (NHSRC) is a technical support organisation under the National Health Mission, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare. NHSRC channelizes required technical assistance for the MoHFW and the States for various tasks. Such requirements are dynamic in nature. Work at the NHSRC is organised around seven divisions, namely – Community Processes & Comprehensive Primary Care, Healthcare Financing, Healthcare Technology, Human Resources for Health, Public Health Planning, Public Health Administration and Quality Improvement.

For improving Quality of care of services, delivered at the public health facilities, National Quality Assurance Standards were developed under the National Health Mission. For this initiative, NHSRC performs task of the secretariat on behalf of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare. In the year2013, QA Operational Guidelines and Quality Standards for District Hospitals were launched by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare. This was followed by development and launch of Quality Standards for Community Health Centres (CHCs) and Primary Health Centres (PHCs), followed by Quality Standards for Urban PHCs in the subsequent years. There is an explicit system of measurement of extent of compliance against each of the National Quality Assurance Standard (NQAS). Each Quality standard has measurable elements and checkpoints.

For implementation of the NQAS, an independent Certification Cell has been created within the Quality Improvement Division for managing NQAS and LaQshya Certification Programmes with the aim of following objectives:

- 1. To plan the National Assessment of Public Health Facilities under NQAS & LaQshya
- 2. To review the assessment report for accuracy and completeness
- 3. To finalize the draft report of assessed health facilities as per the award criteria and provide recommendation to the MoHFW
- 4. To liaison with MoHFW for assessment findings and certifications.
- 5. To ensure timely dispatch of all NQAS and LaQshya certificates to the certified facilities.
- 6. To collect and analyse assessment feedbacks of assessors from the assessed facilities and ensure timely corrective and preventive actions through proper channel.
- 7. To share the gap report with the health facility for improving Quality through closing gaps and identifying opportunities for Improvement
- 8. To monitor the health facility's continued compliance with standards through annual review of Surveillance audit report of the facility

For supporting above mentioned tasks, NHSRC intends to induct a Consultant in the Certification Cell, QI Division. The incumbent is expected to have good clinical background and excellent writing skills. *The*

position requires strong moral and ethical code of conduct with essence of integrity, confidentiality while undertaking the responsibility.

Roles & Responsibilities:

- To provide assistance to the Senior Consultant Certification Cell for facilitation of the streamlined certification under NQAS and LaQshya.
- Coordinates with the respective State in-charge within the Quality Improvement division for timely submission and unabridged document clearance as required for assessment under NQAS & LaQshya
- Scheduling of the National assessment for NQAS/LaQshya, after clearance from the consultants NHSRC.
- Coordination and finalization the team of empanelled external assessor for assessment
- Effective Coordination with State/District Quality Assurance Unit, Facility Quality Team to support and facilitate administrative support for Certification process
- Monitoring & Supervision of the all certification related activities in Health Facilities
- Ensure timely submission of all findings with the MoHFW and State
- Ensure timely dispatch of all NQAS/LaQshya certificates to the State/Health facilities.
- Convening meetings of the appeal committee to discuss the contentious issues and feedback findings
- Supervise and guide interns, fellows and junior consultants for certification process.
- Any other responsibility, pertaining to Certification Cell as allocated by Senior Consultant Certification cell or Advisor QI.

Qualification & Experience*:

Essential:

- Possess a Medical / Dental / Ayush degree from a recognized University
- Two years full-time Masters' Degree (or Equivalent) in Hospital / Health Management / Public Health from a reputed institute
- 2 Years of post-qualification experience (after MHA) including one year's experience of NQAS implementation in public health facilities at district/ State /National level.

- MBBS from a MCI recognised Medical College with valid registration
- NQAS External Assessors
- Robust experience of implementation of National Quality Assurance Standards at Districts/State/National level with tangible results
- Published papers (as main author) in Journals of repute
