- Ensure availability of information from available data sources in an easily transferrable and usable form, based on the requirement of the Knowledge Management and other divisions. Keep divisions abreast of latest findings on key health systems data and studies including SDG and UHC indicators.
- Support in interpreting information obtained from compiled data and reporting their findings to the relevant divisions.
- Support in developing indicators / templates of reports / dash boards / score cards as per the requirement of National
  Health Systems Resource Centre
- Support in activities pertaining to data collation and analysis, in coordination with Implementation Research for Health Systems Strengthening (IR-HSS)
- Ensure timely and high-quality responses to MoHFW and Parliament Questions pertaining to the division
- Support Executive Director in other assignments as and when required.
