

**Terms of Reference**  
**Consultant – Urban Health**

National Health Systems Resource Centre (NHSRC) has been set up under the National Health Mission (NHM), Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, as an autonomous registered Society, to channelize technical assistance and capacity building support to the states for strengthening the public health system. NHSRC is mandated to contribute to health policy, strategy development, national health planning, programme design and evaluation.

If you have a commitment to health equity and excellence, here is a unique chance to work with a team committed to shaping the public health landscape in India. The position offers you an opportunity to participate in the process of strengthening health systems, improving health service delivery and enabling positive health outcomes, through hands on implementation assistance at national, state and district levels. Working with a trans disciplinary team, you can discover, adapt, co-create and disseminate solutions to multiple challenges related to service delivery systems, universal primary health care, human resources for health, community processes, health financing, quality of care, public health planning and health promotion. This is an opportunity to support health systems strengthening at scale, learn from district and sub district implementation, undertake knowledge translation, and enable realization of the vision of universal health coverage.

The position is specifically for the requirement of One, Consultant – Urban Health under the Knowledge Management Division, purely on contractual basis.

**Roles & Responsibilities:**

- Provide technical assistance to states for Health Systems strengthening in Urban Areas
- Support analysis of existing implementation strengths and gaps under NUHM and work with MoHFW and states to redesign selected Implementation strategy
- Support in planning and implementation of NUHM interventions for seven Metro cities
- Provide technical inputs on Urban Health Components in the State Programme Implementation Plan of States (PIP)
- Coordinate with divisions to integrate their inputs/comments on the Programme Implementation Plan of States (PIP)
- Support in reviewing progress of NUHM implementation in states and provide feedback on a periodic basis
- Support capacity building activities for NUHM personnel
- Support in developing Capacity Building framework for states to effectively implement NUHM interventions
- Support in research and documentation pertaining to Urban Health; Coordinate with Implementation Research for Health Systems Strengthening (IR-HSS) platform.
- Support planning and facilitation of activities pertaining to Multi sectoral convergence to support implementation of NUHM intervention
- Undertake supportive supervision and concurrent monitoring initiatives, including field monitoring on a periodic basis.
- Support in identifying best practices and innovations within states and support in documentation and replication of identified practices.
- Support Executive Director in other assignments as and when required.

**Qualifications and Experience:**

- Medical/Dental/Health Science Graduate with Post Graduate qualification in Community Medicine/Public Health/Health Care Management
- Have at least 2 years of post-qualification experience; Experience of working in the public health system and research would be highly desirable
- Understanding of public health issues in India and role of various stakeholders
- Willingness to travel to states & districts to provide technical assistance & ability to work on different assignments simultaneously and beyond office hours to meet the timelines for assignments.
- Computer Skills: Proficiency in commonly used packages like MS Word, Excel, Power Point. Ability to use internet to for desk research, literature review and accessing other relevant documents.

- Essentially a team player with demonstrated ability to work in a multi-disciplinary team along with good interpersonal abilities,
- Good communication skills in English - both written and oral, presentation skills, ability to write analytical reports are all essential. Working knowledge of Hindi desirable.
- Ability to carry out the given task on his/her own or with minimal supervision

**Age Limit:** Not above 40 years

**Location:** New Delhi with extensive travel to states and Districts

**Contract Tenure:** Initially, for a period of one year. (The first 3 months will be period of probation. Subject to satisfactory performance, the consultancy will continue for full one year). The consultancy can be terminated by either part giving a notice of one month in writing.

**Consultancy Fee Band:** Rs. 60,000/- to Rs. 1,20,000/-
