Job Description:

- Coordination with concerned state health officials for surveillance of zoonotic diseases major health importance.
- Undertake field visits to various states to carry out surveillance activities.
- Report to NCDC Delhi regarding the activities undertaken and Necessary actions.
- Trapping of rodent from domestic situations.
- Collection of rodents from wild and per domestic situations by diggings.
- Dissection of rodents and collection of sera samples and organs.
- Collection of ectoparasites for bacteriological examination and susceptibility tests of flees of various insecticides.
- Colonization of different vector species
- Investigation of rat falis
- Investigation of suspected cases of human plague
- Technical advice regarding control of disease
- Providing training in surveillance technique of Zoonosis
- Activities will be carried out using the existing infrastructure at PSU, Bangalore. The consultant will make field visits to carry out the surveillance.
