

Ayushman Bharat



OVERVIEW

In India, more than 60% of the total disease burden is due to non-communicable diseases (NCD) like hypertension, diabetes, heart and lung diseases, stroke and cancer). World Health Organization (WHO) report, states nearly 5.8 million people die from NCDs every year. In other words 1 in 4 Indians has a risk of dying from an NCD before they reach the age of 70 years. 61% of all deaths is due to NCDs. All these are life style diseases. Early detection and timely initiation of treatment can prevent complications arising out of these lifestyle diseases. Adopting healthy lifestyles as a way of life, keeps those who are healthy to remain healthy; and those who have illness to move towards wellness. These thoughts are behind the design of world's largest health programme 'Ayushman Bharat'. This initiative "leaves no one behind."

Ayushman Bharat, is to achieve Universal Health Coverage (UHC). It adopts a continuum of care approach, comprising of two inter-related components, which are – (1) Ayushman BharatHealth and Wellness Centres (AB-HWCs) (2) Ayushman BharatPradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PM-JAY)

1,50,000 Ayushman Bharat Health and Wellness Centres (AB-HWCs) are being established with 'time-to-care principle' of 'not more than 30 minutes'. More than 1,18,000 are already established. Ayushman Bharat PM-JAY, the largest health assurance scheme provides health cover of Rs. 5 lakhs per family per year for secondary and tertiary care hospitalization to over 10.74 crores poor and vulnerable families (approximately 50 crore beneficiaries) that form the bottom 40% of India's population. The recently launched Ayushman Bharat Digital Health Mission (ABDM) provides the necessary backbone for attainment of UHC, by creating a seamless online platform. Awareness about health and services, amongst 'all' is essential for realisation of the vision of 'universal health coverage'.

To provide health education and essential healthcare services Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW) organised Block Health Melas. This was held in every block of the country from 18th to 22nd April 2022. Large states continued to organize the health melas up to 20th May 2022. Kerela started with health melas in May and is continuing till 30th June 2022.

These melas have been attracting thousands of people transforming itself into a 'Health Festival'.

Block-level health melas were intended to achieve the following objectives:

- 1. Build awareness about different health and family welfare programmes, Ayushman-Bharat Health and Wellness centres, PMJAY.
- 2. Facilitate creation of Unique Health ID under ABDM for attendees
- 3. Facilitate provision of Ayushman Bharat Card under AB-PM-JAY for eligible citizens
- 4. Increase health awareness of the population for prevention of various communicable and non-communicable diseases
- 5. Motivate the masses through innovative mass media and mid-media activities to adopt wellness behaviour to stay healthy
- 6. Provide screening for early diagnosis, basic health care services with drugs and diagnostics, teleconsultation with relevant health specialists and referrals as needed.

Intersectoral Coordination

COVID proved that the best way to ensure 'Health for all' is to adopt a 'Whole of Government' and 'Whole of Society' approach. The block health mela is ensuring exactly that. Eight different departments from Women and Child Development to Culture along with National Health Authority and Food Safety and Standards Authority of India as below participated in the ONE-DAY block health mela.

- The National Health Authority and its state counterpart supported creation of ABHA IDs under ABDM, provision of PMJAY golden cards for attendees, creating awareness about benefits of golden cards, empanelled hospitals, treatment options for beneficiaries and continuum of care
- Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) supported in generating awareness on 'Eat Right Movement'. They deployed Mobile Food Testing Vans too at many places
- Department of Youth Affairs & Sports supported community mobilisation with involvement of their Nehru Yuvaka Kendras and youth clubs
- Department of AYUSH apart from running AYUSH clinics in the melas also supported conduct of wellness-related activities like Yoga, Zumba and Meditation and in educating the attending of the melas on kitchen gardens, medicinal plants, and home remedies.

- Ayushman Bharat Health & Wellness Ambassadors of Department of School Education participated in the mela educating communities about the School Health and Wellness program
- Department of Information and Broadcasting supported media campaigns
- The staff of the Department of Women and Child Development especially the Anganwadi workers supported in community mobilization for the Block Health Mela
- The Panchayat Raj Institutions, Urban Local Bodies and the Department of Culture supported and participated in the melas

Support from Government of India

Government of India was involved in providing the required policy and technical support for planning and implementation of block health melas in all blocks of states/UTs across the country. The 'National Guidelines for Conducting Block-level Health Melas' released by MoHFW in February 2022, articulated the objectives of the health melas and the framework for its operationalization.

The Ministry of Health and Family Welfare also regularly communicated to states/UTs in support of planning and organising the health melas. The Honourable Union Minister of Health and Family Welfare wrote to States/UTs Honourable Health Ministers and all Members of Parliament to actively take part in the planning and conduct of health melas. The need for active collaborations with other line departments, community and civil society organizations was emphasised too.

The Secretary, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare chaired an inter-ministerial meeting on the 17th March 2022 for catalysing inter-ministerial coordination in the melas. He also wrote to Additional Chief Secretaries, Principal Secretaries and Secretaries of Department of Health and Family Welfare in the State/UTs to convene meetings with different departments for intersectoral coordination in planning and conduct of melas.

The Ministry of Health and Family Welfare extended support up to Rs. 2 lakh per block per mela to States/UTs under National Health Mission.

Achievements

As on the 20th of May 2022, over 4,849 Block Health Melas have been conducted across 33 States/UTs. The melas experienced a cumulative footfall of more than 47.3 lakh beneficiaries in the three-week span. In this time span, people attending had their Ayushman Bharat Health Accounts created, Ayushman Bharat Golden cards, underwent TB, NCD and cataract screenings, counselling on family planning, counselling for tobacco and alcohol cessation, teleconsultation, wellness activities and many more. Another highlight of health melas was political commitment and active participation of Ministers and Members of State Legislature. Out of the total 4,826 block health melas, 2,800 melas were inaugurated by elected representatives.

The top performers amongst States/UTs in organising the Block Health Melas were

- 1. Uttar Pradesh (820 melas)
- 2. Bihar (534 melas)
- 3. Tamil Nadu (385 melas)
- 4. Rajasthan (353 melas)
- 5. Maharashtra (350 melas)

Community Feedback





INSIGHTS

Health Melas in Andhra Pradesh were conducted from 18th to 22nd April 2022 and were based on the guidelines of the Government of India. These Melas morphed into platforms for spreading information on wellness behaviour, preventive measures for diseases, healthcare services for early detection and treatment of diseases. Awareness, regarding various national healthcare programs in India, was also created through the Health Melas. The Block Health Melas were organized across 72 blocks spanning over five days i.e. 18th April (21 BHMs); 19th April (10 BHMs); 20th April (20 BHMs); 21st April (13 BHMs) and 22nd April (8 BHMs).

To enhance intersectoral coordination and streamline the planning of BHMs, a series of meetings were organized at the state level under the chairmanship of Chief Secretary, Health & Family Welfare Department with the participation of the Mission Director and Secretary. Officials from other departments like Women and Child Development, Panchayati Raj, Culture, Housing and Urban Affairs and AYUSH also participated in the planning of Block Health Melas. Venues, dignitaries inaugurating the event and the dates for the health mela were communicated to all the government officials. To make the Melas meaningful and attractive, banners were put up and so was IEC materials prepared. Several state-specific banners and backdrops, program-wise IEC materials were prepared in the local language and disseminated at the venues. Social media campaigns were simultaneously run on Facebook and WhatsApp to increase the visibility of Health Melas.

The Department of School Education organised aerobic sessions while the department of AYUSH conducted yoga and meditation sessions which reflected the need for overall being of the people as its main focus. As the overall well-being was the major focus of these health melas, so, the Department of School Education conducted aerobic sessions and the Department of AYUSH conducted regular yoga and meditation sessions for people. The success of Block Health Melas is attributed to the concerted efforts and commitment of various departments and active participation of people. The health melas conducted at various blocks in Andhra Pradesh were well appreciated by people. The community members expressed gratitude for organizing these melas in their localities and bringing quality health care at their doorsteps. They even suggested conducting of Health Melas at least once in two years.

INSIGHTS

Celebrating Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav, and the 4th Anniversary of the Ayushman Bharat - Health Wellness Centres (AB-HWCs) in Arunachal Pradesh, a two week-long event of Block Health Melas was organized. The main aim of block health melas was to spread information about the transformation of primary healthcare through AB-HWCs across the State. Adhering to the guidelines of the Government of India, Health Melas were organized in 79 blocks across the 25 districts in the State from 18th to 29th April 2022.

To ensure concerted efforts of all government departments, the State directed all collectors for collaboration with Departments of Education, Social Welfare, AYUSH, Women and Child Development, etc. Orientation of allied departments was organized by Block Officials for smooth functioning of the Mela which generated a footfall of over 15,955 beneficiaries in the two-week duration in which people got their Digital Health IDs, Ayushman Bharat cards issued. The screening for NCDs was carried out, counselling regarding family planning, TB, and Tobacco was done, Teleconsultation and other general check-up were also made available in these Block Health Melas. The melas were inaugurated by Hon'ble Health Minister of State Mr. Alo Libang and by Hon'ble MLAs in the majority of the blocks.

The challenge was to get maximum community participation in these Block Health Melas and offer them free drugs and diagnostics to the people to ensure maximum advantage of the various health services run by the government to be availed of from this drive. To attract the community members in Block Health Melas, the block-level staff took the help of media including newspapers, television and public announcements detailing information on the venue, date and services being provided. The Panchayat Raj Institution representatives were involved to increase awareness of the Block Health Melas. The Department of AYUSH conducted wellness activities for adults and children and provided AYUSH medicines to the patients based on the check-ups done at the Melas. Overall, community members appreciated this one-of-akind initiative and wanted this to be organized more often.



INSIGHTS

To commemorate the 4th anniversary of AB-HWCs, 147 Block Health Melas were organized in various blocks of Assam. The BHMs provided the citizens of Assam with an opportunity to avail free healthcare services under one roof, along with a medium to leverage the rich tradition and culture of the state. The community members were oriented regarding primary health care and the AB-HWCs through the BHMs.

Specific initiatives were partaken to enhance community engagement and social mobilization in BHMs. Miking was done around the BPHC area, emphasizing the Tea Garden area and char/chaporis in the riverine areas. The community members were informed through sub-centers and grassroot level workers, including ANM, ASHA, MPW, CHO, AWW etc. PRI members including Gaon Burahs about the Mela. Beneficiaries were screened for hypertension, diabetes, cancer, tuberculosis, and other common diseases. RBSK team screened school-going students to detect different deformities among them and subsequently referred them to higher hospitals for treatment and care. Diagnostic services like blood and urine testing were made available for communities at BHMs.

Other departments involved in the Mela conducted various activities, such as the Social Welfare Department provided the 'Poshan Mela' activities to create awareness about the importance of a nutritious diet for pregnant women; the Public Health Engineering Department provided information regarding safe drinking water and personal hygiene. Departments of Integrated Child Development Services (ICDS) and the Department of Education were an integral part of the health mela as they engaged in various activities as well.

Patients availing of the services at BHMs were highly satisfied, mainly because all the departments came at the venue saving their time. The Tea-Garden staff highly praised the Mela, as the Tea-Garden workers availed of the facility and were informed about various health schemes like wage compensation for the tea garden community. The local people contributed to the setting up and smooth running of the Mela.

INSIGHTS

The Block Health Melas in Bihar were organized in collaboration with multiple departments such as the State Health Authority, Department of Food, Department of Youth Affairs & Sports, Department of AYUSH, Department of School Education, Department of Women & Child Development, Department of Culture, Department of Information and Broadcasting, Panchayati Raj Institutions & Urban Development, and other departments as per the context and local needs, such as Jeevika and Information and Public Relations Department, Bihar.

Social media messages were broadcast among community members via the Facebook pages of the State Health Society, Bihar Health Department, and Districts to increase community engagement. The Block-level Melas received widespread attention through mass media. Day-to-day news regarding Block Health Melaswas circulated in the local newspaper for wider publicity. Nukkad-Nataks (street plays) and other IEC activities brought more and more people to the Melas. Respective blocks printed and distributed posters, pamphlets, banners, etc., and displayed them at vantage points for creating mass awareness regarding Block Health Melas. The local PRI members, elected representatives of assembly and parliament came to the fore front and appealed to the public to avail the services of BHMs during the event. Besides, the Health Minister, MPs, MLAs, PRIs, State Health Department senior officials and local dignitaries were present at the Health Melas to create public awareness.

Various services such as e-Sanjeevani for teleconsultations, creation of PMJAY Golden Cards, and distribution to Ayushman Bharat Digital Health Mission recipients were provided during these Melas along with healthcare assistance related to Reproductive and Child Health, Gynaecology, Paediatrics, ENT, Medicine, Dentistry, Orthopaedics, Physiotherapy, and AYUSHwas available at BHMs, along with free medicines and diagnostic services.

Under AYUSH, trained Yoga professionals conducted sessions with the general public and peoplewere acquainted with healthy lifestyle wellness activities and were told different waysto improve health their throughminor lifestyle changes. COVID-19 vaccination wasmade available at various locations during the Health Melas. Locals were informed about the teleconsultation facilities being offered through the Ayushman Bharat - Health and Wellness Centres (AB-HWCs).

All government departments were in convergence to deliver public health services to beneficiaries during the event. The State Health Department was instrumental in planning and implementing BHMs which became a platform to generate awareness regarding Ayushman Bharat E-Cards and their benefits, treatment options for beneficiaries, continuum of care, issuance of Ayushman Bharat E-Cards on the spot, and creation of unique Health IDs under ABDM for all Health Mela attendees. The Department of Youth Affairs & Sports involved various youth clubs in mobilizing the community, generating awareness, and displaying IEC on Fit India Movement. The Department of AYUSH was engaged in generating awareness regarding AYUSH Health & Wellness Centers and the related services available at the BHMs and conducted wellness-related activities like Yoga, Zumba, Meditation, etc., for the Mela attendees and extended AYUSH treatment along with medicines to the patients.

The Department of School Education promoted the Health Mela through schools and deputed Ayushman School Health & Wellness ambassadors for the event. The Department of Information & Broadcasting supported Block Health Mela by broadcasting these events on social media like Twitter, Facebook, and YouTube for broader dissemination. District teams of the Department of Women & Child Development engaged AWWs for community sensitization about Health Mela and mobilized communities for Health Mela and also imparted awareness drive by displaying IEC on POSHAN ABHIYAN, including take-home ration, nutrition education, immunization, etc. Department of PRI & Urban Development conducted special gram sabhas during Health Mela for ensuring community mobilization using local announcement and awareness generation mechanisms.

The community emphasized that such activities should be scheduled regularly, at least once a month, or on a quarterly basis. Participation in Health Mela should be encouraged among the private hospitals and public health care facility centres.

PARTICIPATION OF STATE DEPARTMENTS IN BLOCK HEALTH MELAS



INSIGHTS

As part of the 4th anniversary of AB-HWCs celebrations, the Block Health Melas were organized in the 4 blocks of Goa. Along with an opportunity to avail free healthcare services under one roof, BHMs served as a platform to create health awareness and community mobilization. Several initiatives were undertaken to engage the community members and toa lign them towards primary health care and the AB-HWCs through the BHMs. The Health Mela received a footfall of 2,325 from different strata of the population. Special initiatives undertaken by the state to improve community engagement was the Swasth Mahila Swasth Goa project, through which screening for Breast Cancer with I Breast device was undertaken. A demonstration of mosquito and larva was organized by NVBDCP, DHS, to educate the community regarding vector-borne diseases. The PMJAY division put up a kiosk for the issuance of Golden Cards. To ensure that the community does not incur any out-of-pocket expense for attending the BHMs, special buses named as 'Balraths' were made to mobilize the community and drop them back from different areas across the states.

The state collaborated with other departments to conduct activities that required intersectoral coordination, like organizing a poster competition for School Children on "Eat Right" with the Directorate of Food & Drugs Administration. A food demonstration van by FDA was set up in the BHMs, which allowed the community to learn about the food they eat. Another competition was organized for women from Self-Help Groups in collaboration with the Directorate of Women and Child Development. The SHGs also set up stalls of homemade, local cuisine of Goa for community members. As a part of wellness initiatives, traditional games were organized by the Directorate of Sports & Youth Affairs. Yoga is a significant part of wellness initiatives under AB-HWCs, and the same was demonstrated in the BHMs by Yoga Instructors and AYUSH doctors for the community members. Goa's rich tradition and culture was leveraged for wellness activities conducted for youth under Fit India Movement like Mallakhamba. The Medicinal Plant Board of the Forest Department was actively engaged in the Health Melas and explained the medicinal properties of various plants. These medicinal plants with various health benefits weremade available for thecommunity members as well. Further, the Directorate of Art and Culture put up a stall for book display which attracted different sections of the society.

From a community perspective, the Health Melas was beneficial to people in many ways, as awareness was created on a larger scale, and early diagnosis and treatment of various Non Communicable Diseases were held. The community appreciated and actively participated in the various local, traditional IEC activities conducted.

INSIGHTS

To celebrate the 4th Anniversary of the Ayushman Bharat Health Wellness Centers, Block Health Melas were organized in the State of Gujarat. In total, 174 Block Health Melas were organized across all 26 districts from 18th to 30th April 2022 as per the guidelines issued by the Government of India. The main objective of this Block Health Mela was to initiate maximum community participation along with the provision of free drugs and diagnostics to the masses so that full advantage of the various health services run by the government could be availed through this drive.

To ensure concerted efforts, state-issued directives for District Collectors regarding collaboration with Departments of Education, Panchayati Raj, AYUSH, Women and Child Development. Block health officials organized orientation of allied departments for smooth conduction of Mela. Support was provided by India Medical Association as well. The Mela experienced a footfall of more than one lakh beneficiaries in a span of two-weeks. People got all the integral services at one place, such as their Digital Health IDs were created, Ayushman Bharat cards were issued, screening for NCDs was carried out, and counseling regarding family planning, TB, tobacco, and drug eradication was provided. Teleconsultation and other general health check-up were also made available. Although wellness sessions are integral to the functioning of Ayushman Bharat - Health and Wellness Centers, the community's awareness of the benefits of yoga and diet counseling was found to be limited, so, yoga sessions, diet and lifestyle counseling were actively taken up during these Health Melas. People appreciated the efforts put in by the government, especially the Health Department to have organized such an interesting event. The event was extensively covered by Media.

INSIGHTS

A total of 42 Block Health Melas were conducted across Haryana to celebrate the 4th anniversary of Ayushman Bharat - Health and Wellness Centres. The State Health Department worked in convergence with other government departments to deliver quality public health services to the beneficiaries during Block Health Melas. Various interesting initiatives were implemented to create buzz regarding Block Health Melas, such as social media messaging was done through the Health Department of Haryana page and unique awareness campaigns were organized to enhance community engagement for the Block Health Melas. PRIs representatives and other elected members, VHSNC, JAS and MAS members, along with ASHAs, were actively involved in mobilizing people for these Block Health Melas. ASHA and ASHA facilitators mobilized community members to Block Health Melas in their respective blocks. Districts organized cultural events to mobilize a larger audience and to disperse the message regarding Block Health Melas being conducted in the area. These cultural events included arranging group songs by locally available artists and innovative roadshows. Nukkad-Nataks(Street Plays) were also organized to mobilize beneficiaries to the Block Health Melas. Its curtain raiser was done through insertion of advertisements in newspapers as well. The State Health Department planned and implemented BHMs across the districts and issued guidance notes for melaswell in advance.

The key services during the BHMs included:

- RCH services related to maternal and child health, family planning
- IEC activities related to family welfare, sexually transmitted diseases, AIDS screening and treatment;
- NCD related health services;
- Wellness services like yoga, meditation and lifestyle counselling, tobacco and alcohol cessation, awareness related to cancer prevention
- Counselling regarding family planning, TB, Tobacco, and Drug Eradication was provided
- Communicable diseases related on personal/environmental hygiene, leprosy control, TB control, malaria
- Skin care
- Eye care on refractive error, cataract screening
- ABHA IDs were created
- Ayushman Bharat PMJAY Golden cards were issued
- Screening for NCDs was carried out
- Teleconsultation facilities and other general health check-ups were made available

In these Health Melas, people received specialists' consultation for Neurology, Ophthalmology, Orthopaedics, ENT, Cardiology, Urology, Chest, Gastroenterology, Gynaecology and Obstetrics, Dermatology, Endocrinology, Paediatrician, Cancer, Dental, General Medicine, General Surgery, and AYUSH services.

The Department of AYUSH was involved in generating awareness related to AYUSH Health & Wellness Centres and the available services in the BHMs. Department of AYUSH conducted wellness-related activities like Yoga, Meditation, etc., for the Mela attendees and extended AYUSH treatment and medicines to the patients seeking AYUSH treatment. Community members were informed aboutteleconsultation services available at AB-HWCs. Patients were given free drugs and diagnostic services and information about prevalent ailments during block health melas. During in this Mela, free primary health care services and awareness regarding government schemes focusing on health benefits were conducted, while professionals exhorted on the management of various non-communicable diseases. Awareness messages for Yoga, meditation, and other lifestyle practices were also imparted topromote a more healthy and balanced life.

BHMs were organized in cooperation with other state departments. The Department of Education engaged Health and Wellness Messengers and Ambassadors to impart health awareness messages to people. There was the active participation of community volunteers from nearby areas at Block Health Melas, especially in Yoga sessions. Food and water were tested for adulteration under the Eat Right Campaign by the Department of Food and Safety. As part of the Mela, the Food Safety Officer used mobile Food Testing Vans and stalls to generate awareness of the 'Eat Right Movement'in India. Nutritional food was exhibited in the stalls of the Women and Child Welfare Department.

The Department of Culture performed various cultural programs that attracted people to avail of quality services at the event. The Self-Help Groups set up stalls to showcase their handmade products. The Department of Youth Affairs and Sports was involved with various youth clubs to mobilize the community and generate awareness by displaying IEC on Fit India Movement. Theoverall effort of the Health Department to organize these Health Melas, especially the availability of quality health services and free diagnostic and medicines at one place, was highly appreciated by people. Requests were made to conduct such BHMs more often in the community.

In view of Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav, and the 4th Anniversary of the Ayushman Bharat Health Wellness Centers (AB-HWCs) Himachal Pradesh organized 80 Block Health Melas in the 87 blocks of the State from 18th to 30thApril 2022. In pursuance of the guidelines issued by the Government of India, the State of Himachal Pradesh took this mega event as an opportunity to offer the best healthcare services topeople by providing medical checkups, screening for cataract, hypertension, diabetes, etc.

The main objective of Block Health Melas was to ensure maximum community participation to avail of various government-run health services along with the provision of accessible and free drugs and diagnostics to the community members. To enhance community engagement in these Block Health Melas, and to make this mega event possible, it was essential to coordinate with District Administration and other Departments like Elementary Education, Higher Education, Samagra Shiksha Abhiyan, Women, and Child Development, Rural Development and Panchayati Raj, Urban Development, Youth Services & Sports, Information and Public Relations and Language, Art and Culture.

All the Health Melas were presided over by the dignitaries like Hon'ble MPs, Hon'ble MLAs, and other political representatives of the public, large gatherings were seen during this event. Various activities were carried out in the Health Melas, such as awareness sessionsfor people regarding various National Health Programs and healthcare schemes being offered by Health Department in the State of Himachal Pradesh. PARTICIPATION OF STATE DEPARTMENTS IN BLOCK HEALTH MELAS



To commemorate the 75th year of Independence under Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav and the 4thyear of implementing the Ayushman Bharat Scheme, the State Government of Karnataka organized Taluk-level Health Mela from 18th to 30th April 2022 in 166 blocks across 30 districts. Health Melas provided free diagnosis, treatment, and a bouquet of health services including awareness sessions and counselling regarding different government schemes and programs. Block Health Melas collaborated with various departments like AYUSH, Women and Child Development, Karnataka State Road Transport, and Youth and Sports Affairs. The Melas were inaugurated by MPs and MLAs in most of the blocks.

The Mela experienced a footfall of 5,84,369 beneficiaries in the span of two-weeks, where people had their Digital Health IDs created and Ayushman Bharat cards issued along with receiving multiple health services. People was screened for NCDs and counselled regarding family planning, TB, tobacco use, and drug eradication. People were made aware of the check-ups and services they could avail through Teleconsultation.

The Health Melas marked success through the active involvement and collaborative efforts of many government departments. AYUSH department in Vijayanagara district demonstrated Panchakarmas like Shirodhara, Kati, and Greeva Basthi. 'Togalu Gombeyaata' a puppet show unique to the State of Karnataka, was organized, showcasing 12 service packages available at Ayushman Bharat - Health and Wellness Centres in Chikkamagaluru district. Women and Child Development Department created awareness on a healthy diet (on Fast food v/s Healthy food). Karnataka State Road Transport in Ramdurg, Belagavi district arranged free transportation for the people attending the Mela site to avail the services. 'Manasadhara' - Mental Health Programme services were provided at Kodagu district. In Dakshina Kannada district, endosulfan victims set up stalls and sold handmade art and crafts unique to the Karnataka state. Brahmakumari conducted yoga sessions and counselled regarding spiritual well-being in Vijayapura district. Youth & Sports Affairs Department, Chamarajanagara, inaugurated the Health Mela by organizing a Cyclothon.

From the feedback received from the public, the effort by the Department of Health was appreciated, and so was the quality services received by them. The availability of free diagnostic andmedicines was highly applauded and people were satisfied to get all primary health care services at one place. People valued the involvement of various departments in the success of the Melas.


To celebrate Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav and the 4th Anniversary of the Ayushman Bharat - Health Wellness Centers, Block Health Melas were organized in Madhya Pradesh in 311 blocks across all 52 districts from 18th to 30th April 2022 following the guidelines issued by the Government of India. The main aim of Block Health Melas was to have maximum community participation along with the provision of accessible healthcare services including free drugs and diagnostics to people so that maximum advantage of various healthcare services run by the government could be availed through this drive.

Government of Madhya Pradesh with support from NISHTHA -Jhpiego created a digital dashboard to monitorBlock Health Melas. An interactive dashboard was created for the State and District-level Program Managers. In addition to reporting in the AB-HWC portal, data was collected in three types of forms to get a robust picture of services provided in these Health Melas. The three types of forms included: (1) Age and gender-wise data of patients registered (2) PRI members and other key officials attending the Mela and health care workers providing services there (3) Data on additional services like teleconsultation, ABHA ID creation, etc. State Media report was generated every day using the dashboard. The intensive monitoring by the highest authorities motivated block teams to perform better and serve more people.

To ensure concerted efforts state-issued directives for District Collectors regarding collaboration with Departments of Education, Panchayati Raj, AYUSH, Women and Child Development. Orientation of allied departments was also organized by Block Health Officials for smooth conduction of BHM. Support was provided by India Medical Association as well. BHMs experienced a footfall of more than five lakh beneficiaries in an almost two-weeks span, where people had their Digital Health IDs created, Ayushman Bharat cards issued, got screened for NCDs, received counselling regarding family planning, TB, tobacco and drug eradication.people were informed about the services available through Teleconsultation. Considering the awareness about the benefits of yoga and diet to be limited in the community, wellness sessions and diet counselling sessions were arranged. The initiative was appreciated by the community members as they received all the relevant services under one roof.



























The 4th Anniversary of the Ayushman Bharat - Health Wellness Centers (AB-HWCs) was celebrated in Maharashtra through a week-long initiative of setting up of 350 Block Health Melas across all districts from 18th to 30thApril 2022. As per the guidance received from Honorable Union Health Minister for State, Dr. Bharti Pravin Pawar, district teams were oriented regarding the BHMs through a video conference. After finalizing the dates of Block Health Melas, the District Collector convened a coordination meeting to involve all Block-level Officers, Sarpanch, Zila Parishad Members, and Panchayat Samiti Members & Nagar Panchayat Members via video conference, with the main aim toachieve wide advertising and public response in BHMs. The Departments of Rural Development, Education, Social Welfare, and Child and Women collaborated for BHMs.


BHMs were rolled out in coordination with NGOs, private practitioners, media, etc. Certain pre-screening activitieswere facilitated for patient mobilization at BHMs. To ensure wider publicity, banners and posters were displayed and pamphlets containing the available services at BHMs were distributed in all villages and weekly market places, OPDs, COVID vaccination centers, by ASHAs, and Anganwadi workers. Banners were posted in public areas like train stations, bus stops, markets, and schools to spread information regarding BHMs, along with radio publicity. Television networks & radio jingles were used for widespread publicity. Press Conferences were organized to reach to a wider audience. ASHAs played a pivotal role in bringing the Block Health Mela activities to the grass-root level. Awareness campaigns were conducted in the community through CHOs.


A special organizing committee was formed for smooth coordination of BHMs and bring about convergence with various departments. Medical aids for disabled people were distributed in collaboration with the Social Welfare department. Counseling sessions were conducted with the help of a local NGO to increase awareness about the declining female sex ratio with the use of the PCPNDT act to prevent it. Health IDswas generated and Ayushman Bharat – PMJAY Cards were distributed during the Health Melas. Common Service Centre assisted in issuing the PMJAY cards and special counselors were appointed at this stall to inform citizens about PM-JAY. Doctors of the Indian Medical Association, Maharashtra, were called for BHMs to provide special care. Local IMA and NIMA organization specialists and super-specialists were invited to BHMs for carrying out screening, counselling, and treatment. Cancer screening was done in collaboration with a local cancer hospital and treatment center. Onco Life Care Cancer Center, a private partner, was involved in oral cancer screening. Two cancer patients were screened and confirmed by biopsy later. MGM Hospital & INGA Health foundation were engaged at various camps to identify Cleft Lip & Palate in children. With the help of the Education Department, schools and villages were oriented about the birth disabilities and other diseases of children.

As a collaborative effort, ICDS & Health department provided counselling regarding malnutrition. With the help of HLL Lab, the necessary investigation/blood test prescribed by specialists was done at every camp. Nutrition counselling for children and pregnant women was done through a local NGO.Local Patanjali Vidyapeeth and NIMA organization were engaged to promote routine yoga practice in daily life. Special mentors were invited to conduct yoga and meditation sessions at Health Melas. Food and water were distributed in Melasin partnership with "Rotary Club", "Inner Wheel Club," & "Marwadi Press,".

Beneficiaries were satisfied with BHMs as various programmes and specialties came together, and people could avail a range of health services at one place. Satisfactory community participation was reflected by large footfall in each Health Mela. People expressed that such Health Melas should be organized regularly.

The state of Meghalaya observed a week-long initiative of arranging Block Health Melasto celebrate the 4th anniversary of the Ayushman Bharat - Health Wellness Centers (AB-HWCs). Mission Director, NHM and members of other departments such as Education, Defense Institute of Psychological Research (DIPR), Women and Child Development, Rural Development, Sports & Youth Affairs, AYUSH, Food Safety, Urban Development and Poverty Alleviation (UD&PA), Art and Culture Department. District and Block-level Organizing Committee was formed for each district and block. A series of meetings were organized at the state level for planning and organizing Health Melas under the chairmanship of the Mission Director, Secretary, and Chief Secretary of the Health & Family Welfare Department of state. Dates for the Health Melas were decided and finalized. An amount of 1 lakh was budgeted for each block to conduct Health Melas. State-specific banners and backdrop, program-wise IEC materials were prepared and disseminated. Information regarding Health Melas was widely propagated on social media such as Facebook, WhatsApp and through DIPR website. Community members of every block were mobilized to attend Health Mela with the help of Public Address system.

Integrated Child Development Scheme (ICDS) was actively involved in all the Block Health Melas by setting up stalls on nutrition. They conducted counselling of women and children on healthy diet and nutritious food using audio visual aids. They provided and distributed high caloric food such as lentils, flour, and multi-vitamin syrup for children. As an effort to alleviate poverty in rural areas, pamphlets were distributed on rural development projects by UD&PA Department. AYUSH Department contributed to Health Mela by conducting Panchakarma and physical health check-ups. A separate space was allocated for conducting yoga and meditation, in which a trained yoga instructor conducted sessions. Ayurvedic medicines such as Ashokarista, Aswagandhachurna, Chyawanprash, Sitopaladichurna, Mentat, Dasmoolarista, etc., were distributed. The 17thBattalion Assam Rifle F-Company at Siaha supported Siaha district Melas at two locations, i.e., Siaha Block Mela and Tuipang Block Mela. The Assam Rifle supported the installation of fences and stalls, decorations, cleaning of the venue, preparation of podium and donated medicines for distribution during Health Mela.

The Salvation Army church supported organizing Health Mela at Champhai by building a tent, venue decoration, and mobilizing the community to attend Health Melas. The total footfall of Health Mela conducted at Champhai block was 1522. Local NGOs and local pharmacists at various places donated and distributed medical supplies for the Mela.

As Mizoram shares an international border with Myanmar, many refugees flee from Myanmar to Mizoram near border districts. Keeping that in mind, health check-ups were conducted for refugees; the district organizing committee at Siaha organized the Health Mela at Chhaolo in the location nearby to the refugee camps. The refugees were mobilized and motivated to go for health check-ups. A health check-up was conducted for 155 refugees.

Activities such as wellness sessions, OPD, basic investigations, and medicine distributions went well as per the plan. Health Melas conducted at various blocks in Mizoram were highly appreciated by people. There were feedback and suggestions to conduct these specialist health check-ups more frequently.



































PARTICIPATION OF STATE DEPARTMENTS IN BLOCK HEALTH MELAS



Government of Odisha is committed to providing universal access to equitable, affordable and quality healthcare which is accountable and responsive to its people. It is estimated that the disease burden and deaths caused by various cancers during the last two decades have doubled. As per the estimates of Acharya Harihar Regional Cancer Centre (AHRCC), Cuttack, around 12 lakh new cancer cases in India and 50,000 new cancer cases in Odisha are diagnosed every year. Department of Health has to ensure 'Health for All' and in this context, 307 Health Melas were organized at block level from 18th April to 4th May 2022. Various modes were employed to sensitize and mobilize people to participate in Block Health Melas in the state. Apart from miking, radio and print media, folk media was used to create enthusiasm. The staff of the Department of Women and Child Development especially the Anganwadi workers supported community mobilization for the Block Health Mela. One of the highlights of Health Melas was the political commitment and active participation of Ministers and Members of State Legislature. Chief guests at the inaugural function of the Health Melas included 16 Ministers of various departments like Panchayati Raj, Jal Shakti, Tribal Affairs, Skill Development and Technical Education, Drinking Water & Urban Development, etc., 83 Members of Parliament and 108 Members of Legislative Assembly.

These Melas attracted thousands of people transforming itself into a 'Health Festival'. The Melas experienced a cumulative footfall of more than 2.3 lakh beneficiaries in the three-week span. During this time, Ayushman Bharat Health Accounts were created; Ayushman Bharat Golden cards were issued; screening of TB, NCD and cataract; counselling on family planning, tobacco and alcohol cessation was done; Teleconsultation and Wellness activities were organized along with many more activities.

The State Health Authority supported the creation of ABHA IDs under ABDM, generation of PMJAY golden cards for attendees, spreading awareness regarding the benefits of PMJAY golden cards, empanelled hospitals, options for availing treatment for beneficiaries and continuum of care. Department of Food Safety supported through organizing awareness sessions on the 'Eat Right Movement'. They deployed Mobile Food Testing Vans in many of the Health Melas. Department of Youth Affairs & Sports supported community mobilization with the involvement of Nehru Yuva Kendras and Youth Clubs. Department of AYUSH apart from running AYUSH clinics in the Melas, supported the conduct of wellness-related activities like Yoga, Zumba and Meditation. The attendees of Melas were educated on kitchen gardens, medicinal plants, and home remedies. Ayushman Bharat Health & Wellness Ambassadors of the Department of School Education participated in the Mela educating communities about the School Health and Wellness Program. Department of Information and Broadcasting supported media campaigns related to Health Melas.

PARTICIPATION OF STATE DEPARTMENTS IN BLOCK HEALTH MELAS



The Block Health Melas were organized in119 blocks of Punjab from 18th to 22nd April 2022, as a part of the celebration of 'Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav'. The Melas was inaugurated by Hon'ble Health & Family Welfare and Medical Education and Research Minister, Punjab, Dr. Vijay Singla, at Civil Hospital, Phase-VI, S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali on 18th April 2022. The Melas witnessed collaboration from various departments of Youth Affairs and Sports, AYUSH, School Education, Social Security Women and Child Development, Culture, Information and Broadcasting, Panchayati Raj Institutions & Urban Development, State Health Authority and State Food Department, and FSSAI.

Health Melas was envisioned to make the health services available to community members under one roof and near to their households. Health Melas facilitated the provision of Ayushman Bharat Cards under AB-PMJAY and created unique Health IDs under Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission for people attending the health melas. Teleconsultation services were provided through e-Sanjeevani OPD. About 31 blood donation camps and 20 registration camps for Organ donation were organized at these Health Melas, along with screening for Cataract/ Eye and oral check-ups. NukkadNataks were organized as a medium of awareness generation and Health Education for the participants. The State also organized medical check-up camps for screening of NCDs (Hypertension, Diabetes & Cancer) and Tuberculosis, etc. The community was motivated through innovative mass media and mid-media activities to adopt wellness behaviour such as yoga and meditation. Counselling for lifestyle diseases, tobacco and alcohol cessation, and cancer prevention awareness were also organized.

Awareness generation through exhibition display of all services, publicity using Local folk, art, and play. Melas also provided an opportunity to create awareness among people about the various health programs carried out by the Central Government, State Government, NGOs, etc. The Melas attracted about one lakh people desiring to avail of quality healthcare services with essential medicines through different systems of medicine, all free of cost. The community took an active part in on-spot wellness sessions and underwent oral and eye screening. Overall the health melas were extremely popular and well-appreciated by the community members.







PARTICIPATION OF STATE DEPARTMENTS IN BLOCK HEALTH MELAS



Rajasthan organized Block Health Melas from 18th to 30th April across 34 districts as part of Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav and the 4th Anniversary of the Ayushman Bharat Health Wellness Centers (AB-HWCs). In Rajasthan, Taluk Panchayat Presidents are known as Block Pradhans, and there are 352 Block Pradhans at Panchayat Samiti Blocks and Health Melas were conducted at Panchayat Samiti Blocks instead of revenue blocks.

In addition to the activities listed in National Guidelines for Conducting Block Health Melas, Rajasthan conducted state-specific special initiatives like screening of malnourished children, people with disabilities; counselling of adolescents under school health programs; lucky draws to get more participation at Health Melas: sports activities for children, puppet shows. Social media was used to spread awareness and get maximum involvement of people in BHMs. Local PRI meetings /VHSNC meetings were organized to enhance community engagement and mobilization in Block Health Mela. Most of the Health Melas were inaugurated by the elected representatives of that area, including 124 legislative assembly representatives.

Block Health Melas created awareness about various health programmes, Ayushman Bharat Health and Wellness Centers, PMJAY, along with prevention of various communicable and non-communicable diseases, screening for early diagnosis, and essential health services with drugs and diagnostics. BHM facilitated the creation of Unique Health IDs, Ayushman Bharat cards, along with the issuance and renewal of Mukhyamantri Chiranjeevi Swasthya Bima Yojana Cards.

E-Mitra was arranged for JANADHAR updation and registration in Chiranjeevi Swasthya Bima Yojna. People appreciated that all the services, including specialist services, were provided under one umbrella and insisted that Health Mela should be organized annually. Around 3,41,267 footfalls across 34 districts of the stateindicated the massive success of Block Health Melas. These Melas were an example of a successful intersectoral coordination and collaboration with Women & Child Development, Panchayat Department, Education Department, and AYUSH Department.





PARTICIPATION OF STATE DEPARTMENTS IN BLOCK HEALTH MELAS



In pursuance of the Government of India issued guidelines, Sikkim celebrated Health Melas in 28 blocks across all four districts from 18th - 27th April 2022. To enhance community engagement in Block Health Melas, social media messaging through the Health Department of Sikkim page and awareness campaigns were organized. PRIs councilors and other elected members, along with VHSNC members, JAS Members, MAS members, and ASHAs were actively involved in the mobilization of people for these Block Health Melas.

The Melas experienced a footfall of more than 12,000 beneficiaries in the span of two weeks, where Digital Health IDs were created, Ayushman Bharat cards were issued, screening for NCDs was carried out, counseling regarding family planning, TB, Tobacco and Drug Eradication was given. Teleconsultation facilities and other general health check-ups were also made available.

The health melas were organized in collaboration with other state departments, for instance, the Department of Education engaged Health and Wellness Messengers and Ambassadors (School Nodal Teachers) to engage in imparting health awareness messages to people. There was active participation of school students from nearby areas at Block Health Melas, especially in Yoga sessions. The Department of Food and Safety showcased activities under the Eat Right Campaign wherein mobile food vans conducted food and water testing for adulteration. Women & Child Welfare Department exhibited nutritional food in their stall. The Department of Culture performed various cultural programs that attracted many people to avail of quality services at health melas. The Self-Help Groups (SHGs) set up stalls to showcase their handmade products. Information & Public Relations Department took care of pre- and post-event publicity. Block ASHA Coordinators coordinated for Block Health Melas in their respective Blocks. The Sports and Youth Affairs Department actively mobilized youth volunteers in various blocks. Police supported the maintenance of law and order in Block Health Melas and ensured social distancing. Gangtok Municipal Corporation (GMC) under Urban Development also came up with a selfie corner that was appreciated by the public attending the Block Health Melas.

Overall, the effort of the Health Department to organize these Health Melas, especially the availability of quality health services and free diagnostic & medicines in one place was highly appreciated by people.

The State of Tamil Nadu organized Block Health Melas covering all the 385 blocks across the State as part of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav to commemorate 75 years of Independence. The Block Health Melas were organized from 18thApril to 17th May 2022 with the main aim to promote preventive measures for diseases along with healthcare services for early detection and treatment. The Block Health Mela was organized in collaboration with 10 Ministries including National Health Authority (NHA), Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI), Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Ministry of AYUSH, Ministry of Education, Ministry of Information and Broadcasting, Ministry of Women and Child Development, Ministry of Panchayati Raj Institution, Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs, and Ministry of Culture.

Various initiatives were undertaken at the State, District, and Block levels to plan the Health Melas well and to enhance community engagement. At the Statelevel, the event was planned by the Mission Director, NHM, along with officials from the National Health Mission and Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine through video conference. The next orientation on Block Health Mela was organized for all the district-level Programme Officers, DDHS, APM, and other concerned officials. By 14thApril 2022, the guidelines for conducting Block Health Melas were shared with all the District Officials and District Collectors. The Members of Parliament, State Ministers, Members of the Legislative Assembly, Local Body chiefs, etc., inaugurated the Block Health Mela in the concerned Blocks / Districts and graced the occasion with their active participation. This motivated the health workers and the community members to participate in the BHMs.

All the BHMs received adequate media attention and were well documented. Efforts were put in by the State, District, Block, and Household levels, like IEC materials were translated into regional languages for various activities and communicated to districts; the local television channels actively covered all the Block Health Melas; services provided in Block Health Melas were constantly being announced through the Miking system. On the day of the State Level inauguration of Block Health Mela at Thiruvallur District, the inauguration speech was given by Thiru. T.R.Baalu, Hon'ble Member of Parliament, Honourable Health Minister Thiru Ma. Subramanian, the District Collector, and other officials at Vanagaram in the Villivakkam Block with comprehensive media coverage. Social media was also well utilized to tweet the happenings of the BHMs on all official social media of the National Health Mission and Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine.

A minimum of 63 diagnostic services, 172 essential drugs, and a range of services from free diagnostics and medicine distribution, creation of Health ID (ABHA), PMJAY card, Maternal & Child Health services, screening of Non-Communicable Diseases, Tuberculosis, eye and oral health screening, ENT services, blood donation, health and wellness sessions, teleconsultation services, and counselling services were provided in the Melas free of cost. Out of 120 Blood camps conducted, 439 Blood units were collected during Block Health Mela Camp.

The Population Health Registry (PHR), a comprehensive health information technology platform, has been launched as a health security initiative to extend the benefits of digital technology. This initiative has been unveiled with a vision to transform Tamil Nadu into a digitally empowered society that provides affordable and accessible healthcare in a secure and reliable way. The initiative began by providing a Unique Health Identification (UHID) number to all the citizens residing in the State, including migrants, to enable data-driven decision-making at all stages, from resource planning to financial outflow to treatment plans, and to enhance the population-based health outcomes. Around 5.14 lakh individuals were registered in the Public Health Registry during the Block Health Mela. Around 31 Women Health Volunteers in Villupuram district were provided with tablets under Makkalai Theddi Maruthuvamscheme during Block Health Mela to enrol in the ABHA ID generation and TN-PHR activities.

Further, different departments and ministries worked together to strengthen the resolution towards a healthy Tamil Nadu. The Joint Director of Medical and Rural Health Services, all the Deans of Medical Colleges, and Health Programme Officials coordinated and supported the Block Health Melas by providing the services of specialist doctors. Further, specialists from Indian Medical Association (IMA) facilitated and coordinated with district-level officials, to participate in the Block Health Mela and offered necessary medical help to patients and promoted yoga sessions. Empanelled private medical colleges and hospitals delivered healthcare services to people; referral and treatment were ensured under the government CMCHIS Scheme.

Women and Child Development, Integrated Child Development Scheme, and various NGOs, like Nehru Yuva Kendras participated and supported BHMs. The active participation of the Family Welfare Department provided necessary IEC materials and counselling to the community members. The community also benefitted from the counselling provided to children by the Department of ICDS and Social Welfare Department. The School Education Department venues to conduct Health Melas and engaged school students in Health Mela activities. The community immensely benefitted from different facilities provided in Health Melas under one roof.

PARTICIPATION OF STATE DEPARTMENTS IN BLOCK HEALTH MELAS



The State of Telangana organized 119 Block Health Melas to celebrate the Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav and the 4th Anniversary of the Ayushman Bharat Health Wellness Centers (AB-HWCs). Block Health Melas were conducted under the supervision of District Medical & Health Officer across 33 districts of Telangana from 18th to 22nd April 2022, and most of them were inaugurated by elected representatives. The main objective of Block Health Melas was to provide quality services to the community members near their households along with the provision of accessible and free drugs and diagnostics.

Preparatory meetings were conducted across the State under the chairmanship of the District Collector and involvement of the Additional Collector, District Medical & Health Officer, Additional District Medical & Health Officer, Program Officers, and representatives from various other departments. The Block Health Melas were organized in collaboration with other departments like Greater Hyderabad Municipal Cooperation (GHMC), Department of AYUSH, Department of Education, Legal Service Authority, and NGOs like Lepra Society, Indian Dental Association, Indian Red Cross Society, National Cadet Corps and Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports. Activities undertaken in collaboration include an awareness campaign about malaria and preventable diseases with GHMC, community awareness sessions on Yoga and Wellness with the AYUSH Department.

Many state-specific special initiatives of the Health Department were undertaken as a part of Block Health Melas. These include spreading awareness through the release of nitrogen balloons to spread the message regarding improving sex ratio through societal change, public awareness campaign through a popular traditional art form known as Kalajatha, role plays, skits where important messages on different health programs, digital display by LED Screens of all Health Services, nutrition food awareness stall were put up by ICDS, an awareness campaign for Beti Bachao Beti Padhao Program through dance and drama at Block Health Mela by nursing students, conducting Zumba classes for the community and health care workers, street auto miking awareness campaign for Block Health Mela, yoga activities in Block Health Mela, working group meetings to street vendors with the help of resource persons of Mission for Elimination of Poverty in Municipal Area.








PARTICIPATION OF STATE DEPARTMENTS IN BLOCK HEALTH MELAS



The State of Tripura celebrated Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav and the 4th Anniversary of the Ayushman Bharat Health Wellness Centers (AB-HWCs) with setting up of 58 Health Melas across the state. Following the guidelines issued by the Government of India, Health Melas were organized from 18th to 29th April 2022. The main objectives of Block Health Melas were to spread awareness regarding National Health Programmes and various health services being provided by the government so that they can be accessed by people and to have maximum community participation in the event.

To ensure concerted efforts, State issued directives for all District Collectors regarding collaboration with Departments of Education, Social Welfare, AYUSH, Women, and Child Development, Food Safety and Standards of India (FSSAI), Sports, etc. Block Health Officials organized the orientation of allied departments for smooth conduction of the Melas. The Melas were inaugurated by Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tripura Shri Biplab Kumar Deb and by Hon'ble MPs and MLAs in most of the blocks.

To engage the community for Block Health Melas, public announcements were made to communicate the message for the venue, date, and services available at the Melas. Mass media such as newspapers, TV, etc., were used to display the organization of the Block Health Mela, and also the representatives from Panchayat Raj Institution were involved in increasing awareness for the Block Health Melaevent. Department of AYUSH conducted health and wellness activities for adults and children. Health check-ups were done at these Melas, and AYUSH medicines were provided to patients requiring treatment. State Health Agency was involved in the creation of ABHA IDs and PMJAY Golden Cards. Digital Health IDs (ABHA IDs) were created, PMJAY cards were issued, screening for NCDs, counselling regarding family planning, TB, and tobacco, and Teleconsultation and other general health check-ups were made available for the people.

The Mela experienced a footfall of more than 61,000 beneficiaries in the span of two weeks. Block Health Melas had a considerable turnover, and community members suggested having more such events in their blocks closer to their homes. They were satisfied with the various services being provided at the event and were pleased by the information provided by the health providers at the respective booth.

PARTICIPATION OF STATE DEPARTMENTS IN BLOCK HEALTH MELAS



Uttar Pradesh organized Block Health Melas, covering 820 blocks across the State as part of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav to commemorate 75 years of Independence. These Block Health Melas were organized from 18th to 23rd April 2022 to promote preventive measures for diseases and health care services for early detection and treatment. The Block Health Mela plan was planned in collaboration with the Member of Parliament, District Magistrate, and CMO. Government representatives like Hon'ble State Ministers, MPs, MLAs, and other dignitaries inaugurated Block Health Melas as Chief Guests for the event.

The venue of the Health Melas was kept near to a Block PHC or CHC, which gave easy access to the community. Micro planning for Block Health Melas was executed carefully forthe smooth functioning of the event. A district-level committee of 08-10 members was formed well in advance under the guidance of the District Authority (District Collector and CMO as Convener), and a block-level committee was formed, which was chaired by Block Panchayat President, co-chaired by Block Development Officer, Block Medical Officer as Member Convener. The District and Block level Committees ensured the preparation of micro-plan in coordination and availability of Hon'ble Member of Parliament and Members of Legislative Assembly.

A monitoring checklist was developed to ensure proper monitoring and reporting of Block Health Melas, and findings were monitored using a real-time dashboard. There are various activities conducted in collaboration with other departments. All the identified departments participated in the Block Health Melas. AYUSH Department conducted wellness activities during the Health Melas. Other departments such as ICDS, Education, Youth Affairs, Social Welfare, Art &Culture, etc., set-up their stalls in the Block Health Melas. To have all 820 blocks planning in place, State developed a detailed digital micro plan format focusing on the stalls for different departments, deployment of specialists from DH, and CHCs, pooling of paramedical staff such as Staff Nurses, LTs, Pharmacists, technicians, CHOs, ANM at Block facility during the camp day, mobilization of patients and awareness generation through ASHAs and ANMs, ensuring the availability of medicines, diagnostics as per the services planned. This micro plan was implemented meticulously. Block Health Melas had a substantial footfall, and community members were satisfied with the services provided at Health Mela and expressed the need for similar Melas in the future.

The State of Uttarakhand organized Block Health Melas, a week-long initiative, to spread information about transforming the primary healthcare network across the state. In pursuance of the guidance document for Health Melas shared by the Government of India, the melas were organized in all the 95 blocks across 13 districts of the State from 18th to 23rd April 2022. The State Government also organized Melas in eight Municipal Corporations and three Municipalities. Some special activities were executed during the Mela for enhanced community participation, like NukkadNataks were organized where information regarding various government schemes and benefits was disseminated to the audience. The Health Melas were inaugurated by local public representatives, including Lok Sabha MPs, MLAs, blockheads, and State-level government officials. Hon'ble Health Minister, Dr. Dhan Singh Rawat launched the first Health Mela organized within the capital of Dehradun. The extensive media broadcast of the entire event kept the Health Melas in the limelight, which further facilitated increasing participation across the state.

The Mela experienced a foot fall of more than 60,000 beneficiaries in the one-week span, where health care services were provided absolutely free-of-cost, including the creation of Digital Health IDs and Ayushman Bharat cards; screening for NCDs was done, counseling regarding family planning, TB, tobacco and drug eradication was provided, Teleconsultation and other general check-up were made available. Wellness sessions are integral to the functioning of AB-HWCs, hence, yoga sessions were organized during the Mela. Distribution of free medicines, free blood tests, and other general tests were done during the Health Mela. COVID-19 vaccination and blood donation camps were the main highlights of the program. Stalls were set up for issuing certificates to people with disability. Overall, the organization of Health Melas across 95 blocks accompanied by inter-sectoral coordination between other departments like FSSAI, Department of AYUSH, Department of Panchayati Raj Institution, State Health Authority, etc., was an exemplary task that was accomplished meticulously.

PARTICIPATION OF UT DEPARTMENTS IN BLOCK HEALTH MELAS



Being a Union Territory, predominately made up of numerous islands, it is pushing services closer to people rather than people stretching to the service provider which is critical for health service delivery in the UT of Andaman & Nicobar. Local self-governance institutions in congruence with local administration are the most effective mechanism to increase the demand for services and improve supplies. Gram Panchayats and Zila Panchayats along with block and district administrations were key implementation stakeholders of the Block Health Melas in the UT. Special initiatives were undertaken to enhance engagement in Block Health Melas and activities conducted in collaboration with other departments:

- Panchayati Raj Institutions provided support with:
 - o Infrastructure (community hall, mela site etc.)
 - o Leadership (members attending melas and encouraging awareness drive to increase footfalls) in hard-to-reach areas e.g. Nicobar District (Campbell Bay Block, Car Nicobar Block).
- The local administration provided support in South Andaman and North and Middle Andaman districts in the form of providing space for melas accessible to people (Panchayat Bhawan, Community Hall, Village sites, Anganwadi etc.) which are easily accessible to people by public transport.
- Various departments like Urban Development, Rural Development, Tribal Development, Women and Child Development (WCD), Food Safety Department and Agriculture etc. were invited to put up stalls in the mela to showcase the available services to people and to mark the comprehensiveness and intersectionality with the health services.
- The Food Safety Department put stalls to encourage 'Fit India, Healthy India' by disseminating knowledge about hygienic food and a healthy diet for pregnant and lactating mothers in coordination with the Take Home Ration provided by ICDS. In addition, they installed mobile food testing vans to test food quality.
- The WCD Department also conducted anthropometric measurements of women and children (height, weight, MUAC).
- The Urban Development Department exhibited various housing and sanitation schemes run by the government. Special focus was on traditional medicines and people were made aware about yoga, panchkarma, food and diet and healthy lifestyles.
- In coordination with the Department of Culture, cultural and health events like yoga, Zumba-dance, marathon etc. were organized to celebrate Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav under 'Khelo India'.
- Different advertisement platforms like local print media, All India Radio and local channels were utilised to inform people about the organization of Block Health Mela and the provision of services there.
- Apollo Hospitals with its team of experts provided gynecological and pediatric services in Health Mela in Shore Point, Ferrargunj Block.

In general, people were happy to avail the benefits of all the services provided in Block Health Mela like BP measurement, testing of Blood Glucose, Eye check-up, Dental check-up, Issue of Ayushman Bharat health ID Cards and PMJAY Golden Cards.

PARTICIPATION OF UT DEPARTMENTS IN BLOCK HEALTH MELAS



As a part of the celebration of 75 th Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav, the Department of Health of Chandigarh organized Health Melas at three Community Health Centers namely CHC- Mani Majra (on 18th April 2022), UCHC-45 (on 20th April 2022) and UCHC-22 (on 22nd April 2022). Sensitization meeting under the chairmanship of Adviser to Administrator and Secretary Health, UT of Chandigarh was organized prior to Melas with participation from senior health officials and representatives from other departments. This meeting kicked off the preparatory activities for the event. Further, a series of meetings were held under the chairmanship of DH&FW cum MD (NHM) with all the stakeholders from various departments for intersectoral coordination. Roles and responsibilities were assigned as per the Government of India guidelines of Health Mela. Sub-Committees with Program Officers of various national health programs, Department of Security, ambulances, fire safety, AYUSH, food safety, etc. were constituted for concerted action.

Mass media like FM Radio were used for publicity and IEC to generate awareness and to enhance participation in Block Health Melas. Special focus was given to the provision of free drugs & diagnostics, teleconsultation, Digital Health IDs creation, PMJAY-Golden Cards, and NCD screening. Detailed maps and layouts of stalls were preplanned with adequate directions and information on BHMs for the convenience of the general public. Liasoning with local political leaders, volunteers, JAS Members, school health teams, food and safety department, media representatives, municipal corporation, song & drama division, fire safety, etc. was done for Health Melas. Efforts were made to engage local groups, malaria workers and other community health workers to disseminate information and mobilize people to participate in HealthMelas which were organized with collaborated efforts of various departments like:

- State Health Authority (Health Department) for distribution of PMJAY-Golden Cards; awareness regarding empaneled hospitals and Digital Health IDs (Health Department) creation under ABDM.
- AYUSH Department for display and information regarding various alternative medicines, herbal plants, demonstration of Panchkarma, and yoga and meditation sessions.
- Education Department for creating awareness regarding various school health programs.
- Song anDrama Division of the Department of Culture organized NukkadNatak (steet plays) and puppet shows to create awareness regarding various national health programs.
- Food Safety and Standards Department displayed healthy /organic foods and provided diet counseling. Mobile food testing vans were made available at the Mela site.
- Department of Youth Affairs and Sports created awareness on the adoption of a healthy lifestyle under the Fit India Campaign
- Organ Donation-(ROTTO) in collaboration with PGIMER and motivated people for organ donation.
- Department of Women and Child Development created awareness on initiatives for women and children. Then there was the participation of local NGOs working for the welfare of girl child with a special focus on girls' education.
- Department of Information and Broadcasting supported for press releases and media coverage to create a buzz about the health melas.

Director Health and Family Welfare cum Mission Director (NHM) supervised and regularly monitored the overallpreparations and regularly reviewed the progress of Health Melas. This helped in filling the gaps and resolving other issues related to BHMs. The celebration of Health Melas was carried out with great enthusiasm and fervor across the city.

PARTICIPATION OF UT DEPARTMENTS IN BLOCK HEALTH MELAS



The two-week-long initiative was organized to spread information about transforming the primary healthcare network across the Union Territory of Jammu Kashmir to commemorate Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav and the 4th Anniversary of the Ayushman Bharat - Health Wellness Centres. Health Melas was organized in 108 blocks across all 22 districts from 18thto 29th April 2022. To ensure concerted efforts between various government departments in planning and implementation of these melas, the UT issued directives to all District Collectors regarding collaboration with Departments of AYUSH, Women and Child Development, Food Safety and Standards Authority of India, Education, Integrated Child Development Services, Youth Affairs and Sports, Animal and Sheep Husbandry, Department of Agriculture, Department of Information, Department of Rural Development and Panchayati Raj, and Department of Social Welfare. Block Health officials organized orientations of allied departments for smooth conduction of the melas. To engage the community in these Block Health Melas, the block level staff organized public announcements through mass media platforms such as newspapers, TV, etc.to communicate the messages related to venue, date, and available services, The Panchayat Raj Institution representatives were involved in increasing awareness for the Block Health Mela event. The Health Melas were made successful with the collaboration of many departments. The melas were inaugurated by MPs and MLAs in most of the blocks of UT.

The BHMs experienced a footfall of over 17,000 beneficiaries in two weeks. Along with the creation of Digital Health IDs, Ayushman Bharat cards were issued, screening for NCDs was carried out, and counseling regarding family planning, TB, and Tobacco was provided to the community members. Teleconsultation and other general checkups were made available in these Health Melas. Department of AYUSH conducted wellness activities for adults and children. Kitchen gardens were created, and people were made aware about medicinal plants, and the related home remedies. Melas provided AYUSH medicines free-of-cost to the patients based on the check-ups done at the Mela. The Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) stationed mobile testing vans at the event, and awareness on food adulteration and Eat Right movement were done. State Health Agency (PMJAY) and the J&K Bank created Khidmat Centreswhere ABHA IDs and PMJAY Golden Cards were created. Department of Education and Integrated Child Development Services organized awareness sessions for children and teachers on healthy eating, daily exercise, anemia, take-home ration for children, pregnant and lactating women, immunization, and nutritious eating. Department of Youth Affairs and Sports informed people about the Fit India movement. Awareness sessions were organizedregarding services available for the cattle in villages by the Department of Animal and Sheep Husbandry. The Department of Agriculture gave insights and provided awareness on the farming techniques and availability of new seeds. Orientation about the general social services available for the community, such as for elderly pension, student education loans, and assistance for disabled was provided by the Department of Social Welfare.

Block Health Melas had a considerable turnover rate and footfalls. Community members suggested having similar events in their blocks closer to their homes. They were satisfied by the various services being provided at the event and were pleased by the information being provided by the providers at every booth. They appreciated the initiative, which provided health services to all age groups. Also, booths on animal husbandry, social services, kitchen gardens, yoga, and agriculture were unique and informative and were appreciated by people.







PARTICIPATION OF UT DEPARTMENTS IN BLOCK HEALTH MELAS



As part of the nationwide celebration of 4 years of AB-HWCs and to mark Azadi ka Amrit Mohatsav, Block Health Melas were organized across the UT of Ladakh. The UT joined the felicitations by conducting 41 Block Health Melas across the 12 blocks of the UT. The community actively and enthusiastically participated in the BHMs. The UT of Ladakh demonstrated appreciable efforts in ensuring adequate dissemination of information through mass media, including TV channels, social media, and word of mouth. To attract people and to create awareness among the community, pamphlets were distributed, and miking was undertaken. To ensure inclusivity, to enhance community engagement, and to spread information regarding various activities and services in the BHM was circulated on various mobile applications like WhatsApp, Facebook, Instagram, etc. The UT of Ladakh is home to many tribes and nomads. The Nyoma block in district Leh particularly has a significant population of nomadic people. Every effort was made to visit them and educate them regarding the BHMs. Further, to attract the crowd and to ensure emphasis on wellness, the UT leveraged its rich cultural heritage with the community performing the Ladakhi dance (Zyabro), skits, street plays, etc., which were donned with the colorful local costumes.

Collaboration with different departments and ministries was undertaken, like the Panchayati Raj Institution was involved in the planning process of the BHM from its inception by conducting regular meetings with the 'hill counsellors' and community and health officials. The PRI also lent a supportive hand in providing transport facilities to the community to attend the BHMs. Collaboration with the Education Department was sought to create awareness amongst the school-going children regarding common ailments, prevention strategies, wellness activities, anemia, etc. The BHMs also saw the participation of the Department of Tourism and Rural Development. The Information and Broadcasting Department covered the BHMs event daily through their channels- JK 24 News and Ladakh Tribune News. The traditional system of medicine in the UT- Aamchi services were also provided to people. The most heartening collaboration was seen with the Ministry of Defence as the Army Medical Corps (AMC) provided technical and logistics support to BHMs. They were actively involved in screening various diseases being conducted at the BHMs. The BHMs were also seen as an opportunity to promote menstrual hygiene awareness and distribute sanitary napkins to adolescent girls.

An encouraging trend was seen where the UT went beyond the norm of 1 BHM per block and conducted 41 BHMs in 31 blocks. The MP of the UT Sh. Jamyang Tsering Namgyal inaugurated one BHM each in Kargil and Leh. BHMs also saw the presence of other dignitaries like SDMs, Sarpanch, etc. From the community perspective, the BHMs proved beneficial to the entire diverse population, with many elderly people suggesting conducting more such BHMs in the future. The Melas across the UT received a total footfall of 11,409.

PARTICIPATION OF UT DEPARTMENTS IN BLOCK HEALTH MELAS



Block Health Melas were arranged at Kalpeni Island, consisting of 4 Blocks. Kalpeni Island is one of the ten islands of Lakshadweep, which has only one Ayushman Bharat - Health & Wellness Centres (AB-HWCs) catering to the healthcare needs of people and has no private medical facility. Block Health Melas were organized in all the four blocks of Kalpeni island from 18th to 22nd April 2022. Block Health Melas received maximum participation from all the age groups for five consecutive days. Heads of Government Departments, representatives of NGOs, PRIs, and Religious Leaders were involved in the detailed deliberations for conducting Health Melas during Ramzan days and finally fixed the timing from 10 pm to 4 am to facilitate maximum public participation. Government Senior Basic School was identified as a site for Mela in consultation and support extended by the Department of Education, Lakshadweep. Contribution from the PRIs ensured community mobilization. Department of Art and Culture supported by conducting cultural programmes and various competitions related to Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav to enhance public participation in the Mela.

As a part of the Mela, NCDs, Cataract and screening of Tuberculosis, Diabetes, Hypertension, Heart Disease, counselling of psychiatric patients, Yoga and meditation sessions were conducted in coordination with the AYUSH Department. Medicinal plants were displayed through AYUSH stalls. Health-related videos were shown to create awareness during the Melas. Self Help Groups (SHGs), in coordination with the Department of Women & Child Development, coordinated Eat Right Campaign and unique stalls were set up to promote healthy eating practices. Generation of AB-PMJAY cards and distribution of brochures having a list of empanelled hospitals was done. Brochures and posters informing about AB-PMJAY cards were prepared in consultation with NHA. The e-Sanjeevani portal was extensively used to provide teleconsultation facilities in coordination with the IT Department and NIC, Lakshadweep. Despite a population of only 5000 and the Melas being conducted during Ramzan, an overwhelming footfall was received at the Kalpeni Island. More than 3000 people benefited from this Mela by utilizing specialist services, awareness campaigns, IEC activities, etc.

PARTICIPATION OF UT DEPARTMENTS IN BLOCK HEALTH MELAS



To ensure 'Health for All', Puducherry's Health Department, organized five Health Melas across the union territory from 18thto 22ndApril 2022. The Melas experienced a cumulative footfall of more than 2000 beneficiaries in the span of three weeks. Various modes were employed to sensitize and mobilize people to participate in Block Health Melas, like miking, radio, print media The Department of Information and Broadcasting supported media campaigns. The Department of Women and Child Development staff, especially the Anganwadi workers, engaged and mobilized the community members for the Block Health Mela.

Political commitment and active participation from Ministers and Members of State Legislature were observed. Along with the Chief Minister of UT of Puducherry, Ministers from Agriculture Ministry, Health Ministry, and Home Ministry and Members from the Legislative Assembly visited the event. Ayushman Bharat Health Accounts were created, Ayushman Bharat Golden Cards were distributed, screening was carried out for TB, NCD, and cataract, counselling was done on family planning, tobacco and alcohol cessation, teleconsultation, wellness activities, and many more activities were undertaken for the benefit of community members. The State Health Authority supported the generation of ABHA IDs under ABDM, provision of PMJAY golden cards for attendees; and most importantly, spread awareness about the benefits of golden cards, empanelled hospitals, treatment options for beneficiaries, and continuum of care. The Department of Food Safety supported awareness sessions of the 'Eat Right Campaign'. Department of Youth Affairs & Sports supported community mobilization with the involvement of its youth clubs. Apart from running AYUSH clinics in the Melas, the Department of AYUSH conducted wellness-related activities like Yoga, Zumba, and Meditation. Ayushman Bharat Health & Wellness Ambassadors of the Department of School Education participated in the Melas to educate communities about the School Health and Wellness program.
