# Expression of Interest (EOI) for Empanelment of vendors for Designing, Printing, Videography, and creative work

- 1) NATIONAL HEALTH SYSTEMS RESOURCE CENTRE (NHSRC), under the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India intends to empanel vendors having professional and latest facilities of printing & communication material; situated in Delhi and National Capital Region (NCR). The said contract will be primarily for one (01) year, extendable up to three (03) years for making NHSRC publications and other creative requirements.
- The empaneled vendor will be responsible for graphic designing, designing, printing, videography, and translating services of books, modules, diaries, coffee table books, brochures, folders, certificates, Flex, Vinyl, I'd cards, and any other material, Animated video 2D, Animated video 3D, Video spots/ Documentaries/ Films, Audio spots with/ without music, Translations, Editing, Proof Reading, Typing, Transcribing, Photography within the given time schedule. The requisite quantity/quality of paper to be used for printing of text, cover and illustrations are to be arranged by the vendor.
- 3) Interested vendors who fulfill the eligibility/essential criteria and submit all the annexures from (I, IV-IX) will be eligible for technical bid and thereafter financial bid. The vendors will be evaluated on QCBS: Quality and Cost Based Selection (Combined Technical and Financial Score (CTFS) with Weightage 70:30). Terms & conditions, and quality parameters along with other aspects mentioned in the tender form should be sent in two sealed envelopes containing technical bid (Annexure-II) and financial bid (Annexure-III) placed in one covering envelope in the tender box, addressed to the Principal Administrative Officer, NATIONAL HEALTH SYSTEMS RESOURCE CENTRE by 21st March 2023 by 5:00 PM.
- 4) The detailed terms and conditions of the tender may be downloaded from the NHSRC website <a href="https://nhsrcindia.org/">https://nhsrcindia.org/</a> and the same shall be read as part and parcel of this EoI.
- 5) Vendors shall submit their bids within three weeks from the date of publication of the tender notice.

#### 6) **BACKGROUND**

NHSRC is interested to empanel vendors for undertaking a wide range of services prescribed. The services of the vendors would be undertaken for various publications viz books, modules, diaries, coffee table books, brochures, folders, certificates, Flex, Vinyl, ID cards, and any other material, Animated video 2D, Animated video 3D, Video spots/ Documentaries/ Films, Audio spots with/ without music, Translations, Editing, Proof Reading, Typing, Transcribing, Photography. The purpose of this Eol is to shortlist and empanel the vendors based on specific parameters. It is planned to create panel of High Quality vendors who can execute graphic designing, designing, printing, videography, and translating services of books, modules, diaries, coffee table books, brochures, folders, certificates, Flex, Vinyl, I'd cards, and any other material, Animated video 2D, Animated video 3D, Video spots/ Documentaries/ Films, Audio spots with/ without music, Translations, Editing, Proof Reading, Typing, Transcribing, Photography on tight schedules on zero hour basis as and when required.

#### 9) <u>IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS</u>

- Vendors should read the document carefully as enclosed and comply strictly with the terms and conditions before submitting their bids. Submission of bids shall be construed to be acceptance of the terms and conditions mentioned herein and in the Tender document.
- > Please read and note each and every term and condition carefully before filling up the Tender Documents.
- > Tenderers must sign and stamp each page of the Tender Document.
- > Tenderers must submit all the supporting requisite documents in a sealed envelope along with the duly signed and stamped tender document.
- The envelope shall clearly mention the Date, Applicant's Name and Address and shall be super scribed "Application for Empanelment of vendors for creative works – for NHSRC"

#### 10) **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

- a.) The registered office of the firm/ facility/ association/ company (hereinafter referred to as "Vendor") submitting the Bid shall be based within Delhi-NCR region.
- b.) The Vendor undertakes that it is fully equipped with human and technical resources and equipment required for successful and efficient delivery of any work that may be assigned to it by NHSRC in pursuance of this Tender and EoI.
- c.) The vendor should have GSTIN issued by the GST Department.
- d.) The vendor should have PAN number issued by the Income-tax department.
- e.) The vendor should be duly registered with the competent authority in accordance with the prevailing laws of India prior to 31.03.2018 and shall submit a copy to NHSRC of all necessary documents, such as Licenses, Registration Certificates etc., in support thereof, and represents and warrants that it is duly organized, validly existing and in good standing under the laws of its land.
- f.) The Vendor should have a minimum experience of 3 years (i.e., 2019-20, 2020-21 and 2021-22) of running a business in the sectors of printing, publishing, designing, photography and videography, specifically, of producing quality publications, i.e., Books, Magazine, Journals and other related work, and working with central govt./ State Government/ PSUs, Ministries, Govt. Departments, Corporates etc. The Vendor shall submit proof of the productions with the copy of the contracts, local purchase orders, contact details of clients, annual report, contact details of atleast 10 clients, number of employees, etc. alongwith a sample of such publication if so required by NHSRC.
- g.) The Vendor should not have any actions, suits, proceedings, or investigations pending or to their knowledge threatened against them at law or in equity before any court or before any other judicial, quasi-judicial or other authority, the outcome of which may constitute their inability to perform their assignment(s) as per this EoI.

- h.) The Vendor should not be blacklisted by any Central/ State Government, / agency of Central/ State Government of India or any other country / Public Sector Undertaking/ any Regulatory Authorities in India or any other country for any kind of fraudulent activities.
- i.) Copy of any documentary proof to establish bonafides of the registered office (as on date) i.e., landline/mobile/Electricity Bill in the name of the bidder agency or registration under shop & establishment act, local authority or lease agreement must be attached and the Vendor shall agree to physical verification of the same by NHSRC.
- j.) The Vendor shall have minimum cumulative annual turnover of Rupees One Crore in the last three financial years (2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22).
- k.) The vendor should have in-house, state-of-art facilities for printing, designing and all auxiliary facilities in accordance with the requirements in this Eol.

#### Note:

- Non-inclusion of any requisite document or failure to provide the requisite document in the prescribed manner will leave the vendor exempted from being considered in Technical Evaluation.
- The final decision for approval/ rejection of the Bid of the Vendor at any stage of evaluation shall lie solely with NHSRC and NHSRC shall be under no obligation to disclose the reasons for the same to the Vendor.

### 11) **EVALUATION CRITERIA**

Experience	Vendor must have work experience in the field applied (Refer S.No.7) for the last 3 years (as on 31st March, 2022) and experience of working with central govt./ State PSUs, Ministries, Govt. Departments, Corporates. A list of such clients, duly attested by a qualified and registered Chartered Accountant, shall be submitted. The applicant agency should have clients (listed companies) both in Govt., public and private sector; dully attested copies of award of contract (AOC)/ Work Order/ Purchase Order during the last 3 fiscal years must be submitted.
Office Infrastructure	The vendor should be a registered legal entity having a fully-equipped office based in Delhi-NCR with relevant expertise & creative personnel and required infrastructure. Copy of any documentary proof to establish bonafides of the office (as on date) i.e., landline/mobile/Electricity Bill in the name of the bidder agency or registration under shop & establishment act, local authority or lease agreement must be attached. The bidder agency must submit certificate of incorporation/ Registration that should be prior to 31st March 2018. In case of change of name of bidder agency, incorporation in previous name will be counted. Documents executed by the Vendor in compliance of change of name to be submitted.
Financial Capability	The vendor should have a minimum turnover of Rupees One Crore each year during the financial years i.e., 2019-20, 2020-21 & 2021-22 as per audited balance sheet. Vendor will submit the audited financial statements dully signed by the authorized Chartered Accountant. (Standalone turnover of the company applying for the selection will only be reckoned, not of the Group Company or subsidiaries).
Registrations/ Licenses	The applicant vendor should be duly registered with the concerned authority (in Govt. of India / State Govt.) for GST (Goods & Services Tax), VAT/CEN-VAT, PAN, TIN No., Sales Tax, Service Tax etc. as per the prevailing law in India. Certificate(s) duly issued by the respective authority/ Department should be attached.

#### The applicant vendor should have sufficient manpower which includes Creative Team (consisting of Creative Head, Copywriter, Designer, Graphic/Visualizer), Production Team (Print & Electronic one for each), Media Manager [+ One Computer (DTP) Human Resources Operator as Assistant], Client Manager, Computer (DTP) Operator, Videographer, Photographer, Editor, Voice Over Artist, Animator, Graphic Designer, Language Dubbing Artist, and other necessary personnel. These staff members should be regular/ contractual employees of the company, certified copy of pay roll for each office or copy of payment of Employees Provident Fund certified by the Company's Chartered Accountant and/or the authorized signatory must be submitted alongwith their detailed bio-data. #### 12) PRE-BID MEETING

- Pre-bid meeting shall be held as per Notice Inviting Tender (NIT) schedule so as to provide an opportunity to the bidders to interact with NHSRC with regard to various tender provisions/ clauses before the bids are submitted.
- ➤ Request for clarification during pre-bid, if any, may be sent by email on <a href="mailto:tendernhsrcpublications@gmail.com">tendernhsrcpublications@gmail.com</a> at least five working days prior to the commencement of pre-bid meeting. The email id shall remain active for further clarification if any till 12-03-2023.
- > Bidders are required to attend the pre-bid meeting or through a duly authorised representative, failing which, request for any additional meeting may not be entertained.

#### 13) REGULAR INSPECTION OF WEBSITE

Prospective bidders are advised to visit NHSRC website <a href="https://nhsrcindia.org/">https://nhsrcindia.org/</a>. on regular basis for any change in schedule like amendment / corrigendum in Tender Document including technical requirement and pre-bid minutes etc.

#### 14) PERFORMANCE SECURITY

- ➤ The successful bidder shall furnish a Performance Security for an amount equivalent to 3% of the contract value or Rs. 50,000/-, whichever is higher (as required under the Rule 171, General Financial Rules, 2017).
- ➤ The successful bidder shall furnish Performance Security for an amount as indicated above to ensure due performance of the contract within fifteen days (15) or earlier from the date of receipt of communication from NHSRC informing 'Acceptance of Bid'.
- ➤ The Performance Security shall be furnished in form of a Demand draft/ Pay order /Bank Guarantee/Fixed Deposit Receipt (FDR) in favour of "National Health Systems Resource Centre." Issued by a Schedule Bank from its branch in Delhi in the prescribed format.
- ➤ In case the Performance Security is submitted in form of Bank Guarantee/Fixed Deposit Receipt (FDR) shall remain valid for a period of 60 days beyond the date of completion of all contractual obligations of the work order.
- ➤ Failure of the bidder to submit the above-mentioned Performance Security shall constitute sufficient grounds for the annulment of the award and forfeiture of the bid security.
- ➤ The Performance Security as mentioned in the sub-para (i) above shall be released on satisfactory completion of all contractual obligation.

#### 15) AMENDMENTS TO TENDER ENQUIRY (TE) DOCUMENTS

At any time, prior to the deadline for submission of tender, NHSRC may, for any reason deemed fit by it, modify the Tender Enquiry document by issuing suitable amendment(s) to it. The amendment will be uploaded on NHSRC website only. NHSRC will be under no obligation to inform the Bidders of such amendment on individual basis.

In order to provide reasonable time to the prospective bidders to take necessary action in preparing their tenders as per the amendment, NHSRC may, at its discretion extend the deadline for the submission of tenders and other allied time frames, which are linked with that deadline.

#### 16) <u>EMPANELMENT PERIOD</u>

- ➤ The empanelment will be valid for a period of 1 year from the date of award of contract, extendable up to 3 more years (on yearly basis) at the sole discretion of NHSRC, on the same terms and conditions or as amended by NHSRC.
- The Panel of vendors empaneled through this EoI shall be eligible for award of work, as per the requirement(s) of NHSRC, from time to time.

#### 17) EMPANELMENT PROCEDURE

- ➤ The evaluation of the applications for empanelment shall be carried out by the Committee constituted for the purpose.
- > The Committee of NHSRC will open the technical & financial bids received.
- ➤ The Committee will examine and evaluate each application on the basis of information and documents submitted by the applicant.
- > On the basis of evaluation, a list of vendors who fulfill the requirement and provide the most preferred rates shall be prepared.
- > The final decision for approval/ rejection of the Bid of the Vendor at any stage of evaluation shall lie solely with NHSRC and NHSRC shall be under no obligation to disclose the reasons for the same to the Vendor.

#### 18) NOTIFICATION OF EMPANELMENT

- > NHSRC shall notify the successful applicant about empanelment in writing by registered letter or by e-mail.
- > The applicant shall acknowledge in writing, receipt of the notification of empanelment and shall send its acceptance within 7 days of receiving the notification, failing which, the empanelment may stand terminated.

#### 19) AWARDING OF WORKS

- > NHSRC deserves all the rights to grant work as per its requirements and considering the Vendor's expertise and capabilities to deliver the said work within the stipulated time.
- > The selected vendor shall be responsible and bound for successful and timely execution of the work. If the work assigned to the Vendor is beyond the scope of its contractual terms and conditions with NHSRC, the Vendor is required to inform NHSRC of the same, within 2 days' of such assignment, failing which the objection shall not be considered.
- ➤ If the scope of work exceeds the contractual terms and conditions, NHSRC shall invite quotations for the work.
- > NHSRC shall carry out detailed evaluation of such received quotations to select best vendor for that work as per its Policy.

The vendor would be required to develop a specimen/ dummy of the required printing material and upon approval of the same by NHSRC in writing, proceed with final printing as per assignment.

#### 20) PAYMENT

- > Payment will be released on presentation of correct bill in the prescribed format, supported with the copy of the work order of the authorized officer of the NHSRC.
- Any penalties/ liquidated damages, as applicable, for delay and non-performance, imposed on the Vendor by NHSRC, will be deducted from the payments.
- Post awarding of the Bid, penalties for unsatisfactory work will also be factored in the contract.

#### 21) **CONFIDENTIALITY**

For all purposes of this Agreement, the term "Confidential Information" shall collectively refer to all non-public information or material disclosed or provided by NHSRC to the Vendor or vice-versa, either orally or in writing, or obtained by the recipient Party from a third party or any other source, concerning any aspect of the business or affairs of the other Party or its "Affiliates", including without limitation, any information or material pertaining to products, formulae, specifications, designs, processes, plans, policies, procedures, employees, work conditions, legal and regulatory affairs, assets, inventory, discoveries, trademarks, patents, manufacturing, packaging, distribution, sales, marketing, expenses, financial statements and data, customer and supplier lists, raw materials, costs of goods and relationships with third parties. Confidential Information also includes any notes, analyses, compilations, studies or other material or documents prepared by the recipient Party which contain, reflect or are based, in whole or in part, on the Confidential Information.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, Confidential Information shall not include information or material that:

- is publicly available or becomes publicly available through no action or fault of the recipient Party,
- was already in the recipient Party's possession or known to the recipient Party
  prior to being disclosed or provided to the recipient Party by or on behalf of the
  other Party, provided, that, the source of such information or material was not
  bound by a contractual, legal or fiduciary obligation of confidentiality to the nondisclosing Party or any other Party with respect thereto,
- was or is obtained by the recipient Party from a third Party, provided, that, such third Party was not bound by a contractual, legal or fiduciary obligation of confidentiality to the non-disclosing Party or any other Party with respect to such information or material, or
- is independently developed by the recipient Party without reference to the Confidential Information.
- ➤ Both Parties shall keep strictly confidential and shall not disclose, or cause or permit to be disclosed, to any person or entity, any confidential information or the fact that it has received the Confidential Information and related thereto, except to those officers, employees or other authorized agents and representatives and professional consultants of Third Party to whom disclosure is reasonably necessary in connection with the execution of work assigned, and except as otherwise consented to in writing by the other

Party. Both Parties shall take all actions reasonably necessary to ensure that the Confidential Information remains strictly confidential and is not disclosed to or seen, used or obtained by any person or entity except in accordance with the terms of this Eol.

#### 22) **BLACKLISTING**

- ➤ The Vendor should not have any actions, suits, proceedings or investigations pending or to the their knowledge threatened against them at law or in equity before any court or before any other judicial, quasi-judicial or other authority, the outcome of which may constitute their inability to perform their assignment(s) as per this EoI.
- ➤ The Vendor should not be blacklisted by any Central/ State Government, / agency of Central/ State Government of India or any other country / Public Sector Undertaking/ any Regulatory Authorities in India or any other country for any kind of fraudulent activities.

#### 23) DISCLAIMER

The close relatives of NHSRC personnel are prohibited from participation in this tender. The close relatives for this purpose are defined as:

- ➤ Members of a Hindu Undivided Family.
- ➤ The one is related to the other in the manner as wife or husband, father, mother, sons(s), son's wife (daughter-in-law), Daughter(s) and daughter's husband (son-in-law), brother (s) and brother's wife (Sister-in-law), sister(s) and sister's husband (brother-in-law)

#### 24) INDEMNIFICATION

- ➤ The Vendor hereby undertakes that NHSRC shall not be liable for or in respect to any damages or compensation payable to any of its employee, associate, agent or contractor or sub-contractor. The Vendor shall indemnify and keep indemnified the NHSRC against all such damages and compensation, all claims, proceedings, damages, costs, charges and expenses whatsoever in respect thereof or in relation thereto.
